As a platform for innovation in education, CLIx also supports the professional development of in-service teachers, making substantial contributions to teacher education in Indian languages.

The initiative aims to reach a total of approximately 1,100 schools and 165,000 students in Chhattisgarh, Mizoram, Rajasthan and Telangana during 2015-18, as well as conduct professional development for approximately 4,500 teachers.



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
